The Bard of Bodmin returns with his rhythmic tales of sitting next to the toilet on trains, love stories, alphabets and the occasional boob job.



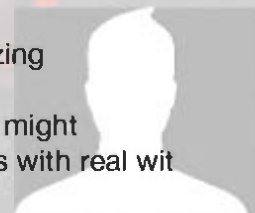
## DES HANNIGAN
